- C. Item Agenda No.3 : UTPs and Convicts with Covid-19 in the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim and availability of medical facilities and treatment.

### State Central Prison, Rongyek and District Prison, Boomtar

Vide email dated 16.02.2023 received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and 12/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.02.2023, received from District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that medical clinics are established in both the prisons and required medical facilities are available. No UTPs or Convicts in either of the Prisons are suffering from COVID-19 as of now.

D. Item Agenda No.4 : Continuation of sanitization and maintenance of hygiene and cleanliness in the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim.

Vide email dated 16.02.2023 received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and 12/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.02.2023, received from District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that at the State Central Prison sanitization is carried out once in a month and maintenance of hygiene and cleanliness is being carried out on regular basis as per COVID-19 protocol and at the District Prison, Boomtar, fortnightly sanitization is being conducted and COVID-19 protocols are being followed.

## E. Item Agenda No.5 : Number of new UTPs since 17-08-2022 and the latest vaccination position of UTPs, Convicts, Officers and staff at the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim.

Vide email dated 16.02.2023 received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and 12/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.02.2023, received from District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that at the State Central Prison there are 97 new UTPs admitted after the meeting of the High Powered Committee held on 17.08.2022.

Further, there are 22 (twenty-two) UTPs who have not been administered precautionary dose of COVID-19 vaccine, 14 (fourteen) UTPs who have not been administered second dose of vaccine as they have not yet completed the time period for vaccination as stipulated by the COVID-19 vaccination guidelines and 03 (three) UTPs who have not been administered first dose of vaccine.

As informed by the Prison Authorities telephonically on 20.02.2023, the three UTPs were admitted on 01.02.2023, 02.02.2023 and 13.02.2023 and had not taken the first dose vaccine. Currently they cannot be vaccinated due to non-availability of vaccine as informed on 15.02.2023 by Dr. Nitin Deokota, Nodal Officer for COVID-19 vaccinations. However, as and when vaccines are received by the Health Department, the same shall be expedited.

At the District Prison, Boomtar there are 74 new UTPs admitted after the meeting of the High Powered Committee held on 17.08.2022. There are 98 UTPs who have been fully vaccinated and one UTP who has not been administered second dose due to nonavailability of vaccine in the District Prison.

They have also mentioned that all Officers and staff of the State Central Prison, Rongyek and District Prison, Boomtar have been fully vaccinated and have also been given the Precautionary dose of COVID – 19

## F. Item Agenda No.6 : Present mode of production of UTPs before Courts and continuation of Video Conference for remand.

#### State Central Prison, Rongyek and District Prison, Boomtar

Vide email dated 16.02.2023 received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and 12/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.02.2023, received from District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that all the UTPs required to be produced only for remand to various Learned Courts are being produced through Video Conferencing.

G. Item Agenda No.7 : Steps taken for and progress of counselling of UTPs and Convicts by Psychologists and Psychiatrists at the State Central Prison, Rongyek, East Sikkim and District Prison, Boomtar, Namchi, South Sikkim (UTPs, convicts under SADA and UTPs, convicts with mental illness, other UTPs and convicts in need of counselling);

Vide email dated 16.02.2023 received from State Central Prison, Rongyek and 12/ASP /DPN/S dated 17.02.2023, received from District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that at the State Central Prison a Psychiatrist is visiting State Central Prison, Rongyek fortnightly and a Clinical Psychologist has last visited the prison on 06.02.2023. UTPs and Convict under SADA/NDPS are being given counseling twice a week through virtual mode by Freedom Rehabilitation Center, Tathangchen, East Sikkim under the aegis of Sikkim SLSA.

At the District Prison, Boomtar, weekly counseling programmes (on virtual mode) on SADA/NDPS are being conducted for the inmates by Freedom Rehabilitation Center, Tathangchen, East Sikkim under the aegis of Sikkim SLSA. Psychiatrist Dr. Shikha Sharma and Clinical Psychologist Ms. Divyaswari Rai of the District Hospital, Namchi are visiting the Prison on monthly basis.

## **RESOLVED:**

The High Powered Committee resolves to request the Health & Family Welfare Department to depute the Psychiatrist and Clinical Psychologist to attend the inmates of the District Prison, Boomtar at least once in two weeks.
