

The Sikkim State Legal Services Authority in view of the Resolutions passed in the 30th Meeting of Central Authority of NALSA dated 27.10.2018 and as per the directions of Hon'ble Patron-in-Chief and the Hon'ble Executive Chairperson, Sikkim SLISA, conducted Induction Training Programme for freshly recruited Judicial Officers on various aspects of legal services provided by Legal Services Institutions on 23rd and 24th March, 2019 at the Conference Hall of Sikkim SLISA.

The participants comprised of Shri Jabyang Dorjee Sherpa, Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate (North Sikkim at Mangan), Ms. Urvashi Pradhan, Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate (South Sikkim at Namchi) and Ms. Zamyang Choden Bhutia, Civil Judge-cum-Judicial Magistrate (West Sikkim at Gyalshing).

The Resource Persons for the training programme were Shri Suraj Chettri, Member Secretary, Sikkim SLISA (*Resource Person for 24.03.2019*) and Shri N.Rai, Senior Advocate, High Court of Sikkim and Senior Panel Advocate, Sikkim SLISA (*Resource Person for 24.03.2019*).

The topics taken up by Shri Suraj Chettri on 23.03.2019 were (1) Budgetary Allocations (National Legal Services Authority Fund (NALSA Fund), State Fund Utilization and Management), (2)NALSA (Legal Services to Disaster Victims Through Legal Services Authorities) Schemes, 2010, (3) NALSA (Victims of Trafficking and Commercial Sexual Exploitation) Scheme, 2015, (4) NALSA Legal (Services to Workers in the Unorganised Sector) Scheme, 2015 and (5) NALSA (Child Friendly Legal Services to Children and their Protection) Scheme, 2015, followed by Interaction while the topics taken up by Shri N.Rai on 24.03.2019 were (1) PLVs- Training Module for PLVs- Roles and Responsibilities, (2) Providing Legal Services at Remand Stage- Roles and Responsibilities of Remand Lawyers and (3) NALSA (Legal Aid Clinic Regulation), 2010, followed by Interaction.
