 Only one female UTP is there in Rongyek who cannot be

considered for release hence;

Vide letter bearing No. 98/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.05.2022, received from Assistant Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that as on 17.05.2022, three UTPs have been vaccinated with single dose of COVID-19 vaccine. On query from the Office of Sikkim

SLSA telephonically on 19.05.2022 it was informed by the Assistant Superintendent of Prison, District Prison that out of the three UTPs, one UTP has been administered second dose on 19.05.2022, and out the remaining two Prisoners who were administered 1st dose on 08.04.2022, one Prisoner has been released on Bail duly explaining that he has to take the second dose and the second prisoner will be administered second dose on 08.06.2022.

Vide letter bearing No. 543/SCP/J/2022 dated 17.05.2022 received from Assistant Superintendent of Prison, State Central Prison, Rongyek, it has been informed that a Psychiatrist from the STNM Multispecialty Hospital, Sochyagang, East Sikkim is visiting the Prison every 15 days.

The UTPs and Convicts lodged under SADA/NDPS are being given counselling three days in a week through virtual mode by Serenity Home Rehabilitation Centre, organized by Sikkim SLSA.

District Prison, Boomtar

Vide letter bearing No. 98/ASP/DPN/S dated 17.05.2022, received from Assistant Superintendent of Prison, District Prison, Boomtar, it has been informed that counseling programme was conducted at District Prison on 13.05.2022 by Serenity Home Rehabilitation Centre, Gangtok through virtual mode, organized by Sikkim SLSA.
